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Nationally accredited individual learner award

Aim Award- Level 2 “Understanding the needs of individuals with PWS” - £409 per Learner



This individual nationally accredited qualification is aimed at staff who work with or care for individuals with PWS, usually from residential care or supported living, education and day services for older teenagers and adults.

The learner will complete an assessment task before attending a compulsory face to face learning session (in Derby) with other learners and the tutors. The remainder of the course takes place as distance learning with 5 guided learning tasks.

From time to time we may offer training days in Derby for health and social care professionals, dependent on demand.
